MPCC Inter-High Rules and Regulations

Registration forms must be received by Wednesday, January 31st for McCook and Thursday, February 8th for North Platte. LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED DUE TO DIVISION GROUPING. We encourage early registration.

- 2. Restrictions on number of test takers, grade levels, and prerequisites are on a test by test basis; therefore you must read the requirements carefully. The registration form should assist in this process.
- 3. Testing tickets must be completely filled out before students will be allowed to take their exam; this can be done prior to your arrival to campus.
 - After registration closes, division groupings will be determined and a list, along with appropriate tickets, will be placed on the registration site listed above. Please notify your students the division in which your school will be competing, this is essential for tallying results.
- 4. Overall school awards will be based on points derived from the number of top three placers. **First place** winners will earn 3 points, second 2 points, and third will earn 1 point for their school. The top three schools in each division will receive an engraved plaque and a scholarship to be awarded by the counselor.
- 5. Five hundred-dollar scholarships will be awarded to ALL first-place winners!
 - a. If the senior winner chooses not to attend MPCC after graduation the high school counselor can then award their scholarship to another high school senior to attend MPCC full-time Fall 2024. Seniors who choose not to use their \$500 scholarship are still encouraged to take advantage of the free three-credit-hour certificate for Summer 2024 coursework.
 - b. Freshman through junior winners will be allowed to carry their scholarships over and can be used in the fall term after their high school graduation (not before) if they enroll full-time. We will track these scholarships and mail scholarship acceptance cards during the spring of their senior year. They will be awarded their medal/plaques and summer certificate the day of the contest.
- 6. Any school having placed a student in the top three positions will receive one (1) \$500 scholarship for the 2024-2025 school year to be awarded to a qualified student. (This does not mean one scholarship for each placer, just one total for having a student place.)
- 7. Scholarships are only valid for the 2024-25 academic year, and are valid at any campus of Mid-Plains Community College. They are valid for on-campus, online, or distance learning courses, **but not applicable to dual-credit coursework.**
- 8. Students placing first, second, or third will receive a medal or pin the day of the contest and a certificate worth up to three credit hours of tuition for Summer 2024, which may be used for online, distance learning, or on-campus courses (**not valid for dual-credit coursework**). Students utilizing these certificates must be 16 years of age, meet admissions requirements, and are responsible for any fees and book costs.
- 9. Students caught cheating will be disqualified. We request that sponsors help monitor their students in order to make sure the day is successful and safe for everyone. Please have a chaperone on campus with your students.
